

A DRAWING FOR MOROCCO

An exceptional sale of drawings for the reconstruction in Morocco, presented at Paris Internationale 17 rue du Faubourg Poissonnière 75009 Paris, from October 17 to 22, 2023.

AN EXHIBITION AND SALE OF CONTEMPORARY ARTWORKS CREATED BY NEARLY ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY INTERNATIONAL ARTISTS, ENTITLED A DRAWING FOR MOROCCO, WILL TAKE PLACE FROM OCTOBER 17 TO 22, 2023, IN PARIS, IN THE HEART OF PARIS INTERNATIONALE ART FAIR, A GENEROUS PARTNER.

The earthquake of unprecedented magnitude which tragically struck the valleys and mountains of the Atlas, in the south of Morocco, immediately generated a worldwide impulse of solidarity to help the local population. After the humanitarian emergency, emerged the observation of the desolation of the buildings in villages, and of a unique architectural heritage in danger. The agro-pastoral way of life known in this region is today threatened.

Mouna Mekouar, Mustapha Bouhayati, Samy Ghiyati and Nicolas Nahab, decided to launch a fundraiser to contribute to a reconstruction initiative like no other, based on architectural principles and vernacular construction techniques which take into account local seismic knowledge and a necessary environmental resilience.

This call for donations is carried out through an exhibition and sale of drawings, during the week of contemporary art fairs, in Paris, thanks to the friendship and spontaneous hospitality of the organizers of Paris Internationale.

Nearly one hundred and twenty artists from around the world generously gifted one or several drawings each. These works, all produced on A5 paper will be presented anonymously and will be offered for sale, without bidding, at a single price. All profits from this sale will go to the A Drawing for Morocco fund, which will support several associative initiatives led by Salima Naji, an anthropologist and architect who has worked for more than twenty years in these regions.
